The proposed theme: *Is Gray Hair a Sign of Wisdom?* During the year of the Tercentenary, this retreat invited us to dwell deeply into "The Love of Eternal Wisdom." It allowed renewing our understanding of this founding book of the spirituality of St. Louis-Marie de Montfort.

We hope to find each other again in Saint-Laurent, in 2016, this time with a wider group of the Montfort family. We are grateful for this encounter and for another opportunity to deepen our spirituality.
